I will also be sending a letter by email on Thursday welcoming successful applicants to the school and giving important information about next steps.

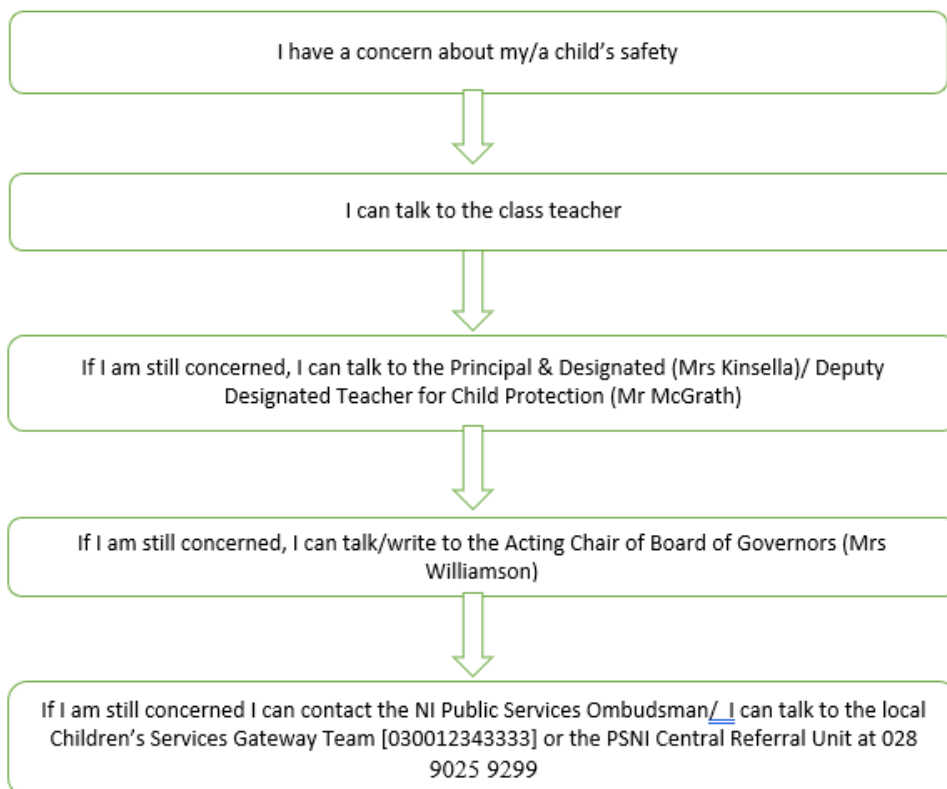
UNIFORM
